Town of Cairo Special End of Year Meeting @ 9:00 AM Location: Town Hall Meeting Room

December 28, 2016

The Town Board of the Town of Cairo met for a Special End of Year Town Board meeting on Wednesday, December 28, 2016 at the Town Hall Main Street, Cairo, New York.

Supervisor Dan Benoit called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM and then asked the attendees to Pledge Allegiance to the Flag. The following Board Members were in attendance: Councilperson Joyce and Councilperson Ostrander. Councilperson Cords and Councilperson Warner were absent.

Resolution No. 259 -16 "Amend Resolution 240-16 – Standard Work Day Reporting" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Joyce:

Be it resolved, the Town Board of the Town of Cairo does hereby amend Resolution No. 240-16 – Standard Work Day Reporting to amend the hours worked per month for Tanja Sirago from 1.4 days to 2.8 days per month.

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 260 - 16 "Sewer Billing Adjustment" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Ostrander:

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Sewer billing adjustment to be authorized by the Town Board and documented in the minutes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby accept the adjustments to the Sewer Bill dated November 15, 2016, to Account Number 5530, in the amount of \$582.08.

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 261 - 16 "Accept Water Billing" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Ostrander:

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Water Billing be authorized by the Town Board and documented in the minutes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby accept the billing of additional service charges of \$450.00 from the Water Administrator dated October 3, 2016.

Resolution No. 262 - 16 "Accept Sewer Penalties" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Ostrander:

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Water Billing be authorized by the Town Board and documented in the minutes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby accept the Sewer Penalties from the Sewer Administrator in the amount of \$2675.76 dated December 21, 2016.

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 263 - 16 "Inter-fund Transfer from Sewer Fund" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Ostrander:

WHEREAS, there is an inter-fund loan from the general fund to the sewer fund in the amount of \$304,086.75; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 Budget allocated \$3,500.00 to be paid to the General Fund; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Cairo does hereby authorize an interfund transfer of \$3,500.00 from the Sewer Fund to the General Fund to be applied towards the inter-fund loan balance of \$304,086.75

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 264-16 "Write-off Rent from Inter-fund Loan" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Joyce:

WHEREAS, the animal control shelter is utilizing 560 sq. ft. of the WWTP garage; and **WHEREAS,** the Cairo Town Board deemed that a fee of \$4.00 per sq. ft. which includes a stipend for electric, heat and water would be sufficient for rent; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer District has an inter-fund loan from the General Fund, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in lieu of cash rent to the Sewer District from the General Fund, the monthly sum of \$186.67 will be written off the inter-fund loan balance of \$304,086.75 due to the General Fund for an annual amount of \$2,240.04 for fiscal year 2016.

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 265 - 16 "Inter-fund Transfer from Water Fund to General Fund" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Joyce:

WHEREAS, the Cairo Water District owes, through inter-fund borrowing, the sum of \$53,724.67 to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient Water District Funds to pay \$10,000.00 to the General Fund; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Cairo does hereby authorize an interfund transfer of \$10,000.00 from the Water Fund to the General Fund.

All members in favor – motion carried.

Resolution No. 266 - 16 "Budget Amendments and Payment of Bills on Abstract #325" offered by Supervisor Benoit and seconded by Councilperson Joyce:

WHEREAS, town law requires that no fund or appropriation account may be overdrawn; and

WHEREAS, payment of bills should be properly authorized and documented in the minutes; therefore be it

RESOLVED, the Town Board does hereby authorize the following budget amendments:

WHEREAS, the town received 911 sign monies from residents for the purchase of 911 signs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for accounting purposes to track the expenses and revenues associated with these funds; therefore be it

RESOLVED, the Town Board does hereby authorize the Town Supervisor to amend the expense line item A-3010.46 Public Safety – 911 Signs to reflect the increase in General Fund Appropriations \$17.50 and; increase the revenue line item A-3389 Other Public Safety to reflect the increase in General Fund Revenue in the amount of \$17.50 in the 2016 budget.

Resolution No. 268 - 16 "Accept Rider to MVP Health Insurance" offered by Councilperson Ostrander and seconded by Councilperson Joyce:

Be it resolved, the Town Board of the Town of Cairo does hereby approve the addition of a Rider to the Town's MVP Health Plan to include employees dependents up to age of turning 30 years old.
