

## **Minutes**

Town of Cairo Town Board Meeting @ 7:00 pm Location: Town Hall Meeting Room

December 4, 2017

The Town Board of the Town of Cairo met for a monthly Board Meeting on Monday, December 4, 2017 at the Town Hall, Main Street, Cairo, New York.

Supervisor Benoit called the meeting to order at 7:10pm and asked the attendees to Pledge Allegiance to the Flag. The following Town Board Members were present: Councilperson Cords, Councilperson Warner, and Councilperson Joyce. Councilperson Ostrander was absent.

## PUBLIC HEARING ON REZONING OF 136 BROSS STREET

Supervisor Benoit opened the public hearing. Mr. Suwara presented his intentions to the public, submitted maps and seqra form. Residents concerned about traffic, property values and the scenic views. Supervisor Benoit read the seqra and explained to the audience the process of rezoning. The seqra will now go to the county planning with form 239 referral and we will wait on their response. The public hearing will remain open until the Town board reviews the county's response on January 8, 2017 meeting.

Delaware Engineering gave an update on the water. The contract for the water meters has been awarded, contract signed and parts are ordered. Water meter replacements will be scheduled in the next couple of weeks. The test well for water source by wells three and four were insufficient. The wells cannot produce enough water. There is potential for 100 gallons per minute by the Catskill Creek.

Supervisor Benoit gave an update on sidewalks. The town received approval from USDOT to spend monies. Next step is to bond the money.

Supervisor Benoit stated that he never noticed the pig farm Town health meeting. The Town health meeting will be December 11, 2017 at 7:00pm.

Supervisor Benoit informed the Town Board that they will have a meeting on December 27, 2017 at 7:00pm to pay the end of year bills. The reorganizational meeting will January 1, 2018 at 7:00pm and a Town Board Regular Meeting on January 8, 2018 at 7:00pm.

**RESOLVED**, that the Cairo Town Board does hereby approve the request from the Town of Cairo Police Administrator to attend a Police Instructor Development Course in the amount of \$400.

WHEREAS, the 2x4 high density urethane carved/23 ct. gold letters would be consistent and long lasting similar to the town park signs; therefore be it,

**RESOLVED**, that the Cairo Town Board does hereby approve the chosen design for the Town Hall sign in the amount of \$1,800, and be it further,

**RESOLVED,** that the Cairo Town Board does hereby choose sign # 1 as displayed on the attached print out.
