Town Board Work Session

Wednesday January 20th, 2021

The Town Board of the Town of Cairo met for a work session meeting on Wednesday January 20th, 2021 at the Town Hall, Main Street, Cairo, New York.

Supervisor Coyne called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM and then asked the attendees to Pledge Allegiance to the Flag.

Items to Discuss:

- 1. Request for Use of Town Property request by Nicole Cook and the Greene County Bombers Baseball team to host a Winter Festival at the Town Park on December 4th, 2021
 - a. Resolution No. 2021-050 "Request Use of the Town Park for Winter Festival"
