

- I have attached a Collection Summary which indicates all transactions through June 11, 2024. As indicated, 88% of the warrant has been collected totaling an amount of \$7,410,284.72. As of this date there are 259 parcels in Roll 1 that remain unpaid.
- A check in the amount of \$4315.16 was written to the Town of Cairo on June 11, 2024 for May interest (\$5.91) May penalties (\$4211.25) and May 2<sup>nd</sup> notice fees (\$98.00) Checks will continue to be remitted by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month for interest and penalties as mandated by law.
- A check was submitted to the Greene County Treasurer's office on June 11, 2024 in the amount of \$90,000.00 to go toward the County portion of the warrant. Checks will continue to be remitted to the County by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month as mandated by law. I have attached a summary of payments to the County for your information.
