- Earl asks why the EMS Budget has doubled. The Board pointed out that is has not, it's gone up about \$74,000.
 - He then asks if the Cairo Ambulance is going to be similar to Coxsackie EMS Transport, which is more wide spread in helping other EMS Dept. when needed; since the Town is keeping the old Ambulance. The Board says that they can help when available but there main priority are the residents of Cairo.
- Earl then asks about the Library's Budget and why we don't see a breakdown of the \$220,000 that the Library receives.
 - Mark Goelick goes on to say that the \$220,000 is under the Library Contractual line in the budget and the Library is under the Direct Supervision of New York State so there are certain things that the Library does differently, then the rest of the Departments.

- Overall the Preliminary Budget has increase a total of \$12,979.00 and is to be approved on the Nov. 4th, 2024 meeting date.
